The stock option award is time vested based generally on continued service and is scheduled to vest in equal installments on each of the first, second and third anniversaries of the date of the grant, which grant occurred on May 30, 2012. Stock options with respect to 10,000 common shares vested and became exercisable on the first anniversary of the date of grant.
- Granted pursuant to the NMI Holdings, Inc. 2012 Stock Incentive Plan. The stock option award is time vested based generally on continued service and is scheduled to vest in equal installments on each of the first, second and third anniversaries of the date of the grant, which grant occurred on November 7, 2012. Stock options with respect to 10,000 common shares vested and became exercisable on the first anniversary of the date of grant.
- Granted pursuant to the NMI Holdings, Inc. 2012 Stock Incentive Plan. The stock option award is time vested based generally on continued service and is scheduled to vest in equal installments on each of the first, second and third anniversaries of the date of the grant, which grant occurred on February 14, 2013.
- Granted pursuant to the NMI Holdings, Inc. 2012 Stock Incentive Plan. Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one NMI Holdings, Inc. common share upon vesting and settlement. The restricted stock unit award is scheduled to vest as follows: (i) 1,667 units will vest based on continued service on the second anniversary date following the grant date, on November 7, 2014, (ii) 1,666 units will vest based on continued service on the third anniversary date following the grant date, on November 7, 2015, (iii) 2,224 units will vest after the per share stock price equals or exceeds \$14.00 for a 30-day trading period, and (iv) 2,221 units will vest after the per share stock price equals or exceeds \$16.00 for a 30-day trading period.
